

The 1st Jamal Nazrul Islam National Conference, 2022 (JNINC 2022) for Young Researchers is dedicated to the spirit of a legendary mathematical physicist, cosmologist and the former professor of the University of Chittagong, Dr. Jamal Nazrul Islam. This conference is a collaborative initiative of Jamal Nazrul Islam Research for Mathematical and Physical Science, University of Chittagong and Chittagong University Research and Higher Study Society (CURHS). The conference is aimed at introducing the state of the art and science of research for the next generation academic leaders and intended to welcome new research findings, scholarly articles and critical essays.

Event Segments

Oral presentation: [research based] (7 minutes oral presentation of a research work): Selected 7 abstracts from each category will be invited for oral presentation. Abstracts not nominated for oral presentations will be invited for poster presentation. Best presentation from each category will be awarded. Language of the presentation will be English.

Poster presentation: [Both idea and research based] Poster on any research work can be presented. Only one author of each paper will be allowed to present the poster and participate in the conference. Best presentation from each category will be awarded. Language of the presentation will be English.

Three Minute Thesis (in Bangla): Participant has to present his/her thesis work in 3 minutes using the medium of Bangla. S/he cannot use any jargon/ technical term and it has to be understandable to the general audience. Participants have to send a video of his/her presentation to the conference email (ini.nationalconference@cu.ac.bd) mentioning "3-minute thesis" as the subject and must also register. Top 10 participants will be invited over zoom for semifinal (schedule will be announced soon). Top 5 participants will be invited for stage performance for the final round on the day of conference.

Eligibilities of the Participants

Current Undergraduate, Masters, M.Phil. and PhD students from any Bangladeshi university or institution and independent researchers between the age of 18-35 years can submit abstracts for the conference.
