(Faculty of Medicine, Surgery, Basic Science & Para Clinical Science, Dentistry and Paediatrics)

1. All Govt./Autonomous candidates should know Deputation Rules/Study leave rules of their employer.
2. **Private candidates already in a course can not apply, but they are eligible to apply one year after withdrawal from the course (copy of withdrawal letter is to be submitted).**

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) for Admission Test July 2026

1. Question:

Which documents a candidate should have during submission of her/his application?

Answer:

Following documents are required to provide correct information,

- i. Permanent and updated BMDC Registration (valid on or after 31st December 2026).
- ii. National Identification Card (NID).
- iii. Internship Certificate.
- iv. Job Related Documents.

2. Question:

Which items a Candidate have to scan and upload along with the application?

Answer:

A Candidate should scan images (.jpg format) of-

- i. Her/his passport size color Photograph (image size : 500×500 px, not older than three months & background must be of one color preferably white where face should be very clearly seen)
- ii. Signature (image size : 300×200 px) and
- iii. Bank Deposit Receipt (image size : 500×500 px)

3. Question:

Which information from Bank Deposit Receipt is to be mentioned?

Answer:

- i. Bank batch/serial number (Maximum digit of numbers-which is to write in 1st field)
- ii. Scroll number (without Shahbag Avenue branch, all branches Scroll number is 1-which is to write in 2nd field)
- iii. Date of Money deposit (Select from calendar of Online system)
- iv. Name of the Branch

4. Question:

When a candidate can get her/his Admit Card?

Answer:

Candidates can print **Admit Card from M.Phil, M.MEd. & Diploma 07 to 13 March 2026 and M.Phil PSM & MPH Program 09 to 13 March 2026 (upto 10:00AM)** using his/her application number & password.

5. Question:

Is there any age limit for applying?

Answer:

- a) Yes-maximum 45-year age as on 30 June 2026.
- b) BMU Candidates :

i. Age is relaxable upto 57-year only for BMU Candidates (Consultant, Medical Officer & Research Assistant) who are appointed from 2003 to 2006.

ii) Others Candidates 52 years

- c) Age is relaxable upto 52-year only for Private Candidates having Diploma degree.
- d) For M.MEd. course, age is relaxable upto maximum 52-year for Govt. candidates and maximum 55-year for BMU Teachers on or before 30 June 2026.

6. Question:

Is completion of internship mandatory?

Answer:

Yes, must complete one year internship.

7. Question:

Is any period is necessary after internship?

Answer:

Yes, one year after completion of internship on or before 30 June 2026 is mandatory.

8. Question:

Is provisional registration number of BMDC is acceptable?

Answer:

No, candidate must have permanent registration number of BMDC, validity on or after 31st December 2026


9. Question:

How many years, a government candidate, need to serve before applying for admission into Post-graduate course?

Answer:

At least 2 (two) years of active service upto 30 June 2026 for all courses except:

- a. Applicants working in remote area (as per Govt. Deputation Rules) can apply after 01(one) year of service.
- b. Applicants for the disciplines of Basic science & Paraclinical science, DA, DFM, DLM, DBS&T and MPH in Community Medicine course can apply without any job experience in Govt. service.

10. Question :

Is BMU quota applicable for Medical Officer/Research Assistant working in Bangladesh Medical University?

Answer:

Yes, BMU quota is applicable for Permanent Medical Officer/Research Assistant working in Bangladesh Medical University.

11. Question:

How many years of Government service are required after last deputation?

Answer:

Candidate must know the Govt. Deputation Rules.

12. Question:

Is a candidate eligible for form fill-up after willingly leave course/cancellation of deputation/failed in any previous course?

Answer:

Deputation Rules will be followed for Govt. candidates.

BMU candidates will become eligible to apply in any course after 02 (two) years of willingly withdrawal/could not pass in any previous course from the course upto 30 June 2026. In that case, the BMU candidate will have to compete in General Quota.

In case of private candidates, **one year is required after willingly withdrawal/could not pass in any previous course from the course upto 30 June 2026.**

13. Question:

Can a candidate choose more than 01 (one) discipline?

Answer:

No, candidate has to choose 01 (one) discipline only. After final submission, no change of discipline will be allowed. A candidate will be allowed to apply only once in a session (except MPH Program).

14. Question:

Can a candidate choose more than one institute?

Answer:

Yes, candidate can choose maximum of 07 (seven) institutes (if options of institutes are available for that particular discipline).

15. Question:

Can a candidate choose more than one Discipline & institute?

Answer:

Yes, candidate can choose maximum of 03 (three) Disciplines & 03 (three) institutes for MPH Program of Admission Test (if options of institutes are available for that particular discipline).

16. Question:

How many years required for a Govt. candidate to give service in respective specialty after obtaining any postgraduate degree?

Answer:

Govt. candidates must have 01 (one) year active service upto 30 June 2026 in the respective field after obtaining any postgraduate degree.

17. Question:

Can the information provided in the application form be modified?

Answer:

Candidate can modify their application as long as she/he not pressed the 'Final Submit' button. Once the 'Final Submit' button has been pressed, candidate is no longer allowed to modify.

18. About any wrong/fake information:

If any candidate provide any wrong/fake information during online form fill-up or in any stage of admission process, his/her selection/admission will be cancelled and he/she will be subjected to legal proceedings as per procedures of Bangladesh Medical University.

19. About right of authority to cancel/modify/change any information :

The authority reserves the right to cancel/modify/change any information given in the Admission Notice, Eligibility Criteria & Information, FAQs and in online steps of Admission process.
