- Minimum two years of clinical experience after passing B.Sc in nursing degree. (Bachelor of Science in Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc in Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc in Public Health Nursing).
- Permanent registration certificate from BNMC Valid up to 31st December 2025.
- Permission letter from the institute for on job applicants.
- Maximum 45 years age as on 1st July 2025 (according to SSC certificate).
- National ID.

**Eligibility Criteria & other information for
Master of Science in Nursing (MSN) Program July-2025**

1. All Government/Autonomous applicants should know Government service rules/study leave rules of their employer.
2. Applicants must choose any three nursing specialties (where options are available) from specified six specialties.
3. **Candidates should have:**
 - a. **For National applicants:**
 - i. Bachelor of Science in Nursing or Bachelor of Science in Midwifery from a School recognized by the Bangladesh Nursing and Midwifery Council (BNMC).
 - ii. At least two years of clinical experience as a registered Nurse (must upload during online form fill-up).
 - iii. Permanent registration from BNMC valid up to 31st December-2025.
 - iv. Maximum 45-year age as on 1st July 2025.
 - v. Copy of National ID.
 - vi. Passport Size Photograph.
 - vii. Permission letter from the institute for on job applicants (must upload during online form fill-up).
 - b. **For International Applicants:**
 - i. Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) or equivalent certificate recognized by BNMC.
 - ii. At least two years of clinical experience as registered Nurse after obtaining BSN degree (must upload during online form fill-up).
 - iii. No Objection certificate from their respective Missions/ Embassies in Bangladesh or other relevant Organizations.
 - iv. Maximum 45 year age as on 1st July 2025
 - v. International English Language Testing System (IELTS), a minimum score of 5.5 'IELTS' Certificate can be submitted at the time of admission.
 - vi. Copy of Passport.
 - vii. Official educational transcripts (Minimum 55% percentage) from all post-Secondary Schools attended (International transcripts must be in English or translated in English and authenticated by Notary Public or equivalent Agency).
 - viii. Personal statement (500~700 words including a plan of study, area of research interest, reason for applying and interview).
 - ix. Passport Size Photograph.
 - x. Applicants must appear before an interview board.
 - xi. Applicants must choose any three nursing specialties (where options are available) from specified six specialties.

i.	Color Photograph (JPEG format)
ii.	Signature (JPEG format)
iii.	Bank Payment Receipt (JPEG format)
iv.	Permission letter from the institute for on job applicants (JPEG format)
v.	Letter of two years experience (JPEG format)
3.	Question: Which information from bank deposit receipt is to be mentioned?

i.	Bank scroll number
ii.	Date of money deposit
iii.	Name of the branch of Pubali Bank PLC.
4.	Question: When a candidate can get her/his Admit Card?
Answer	
Admit Card print out date & time will be informed in the candidate's mobile number and in the University website (www.bmu.ac.bd) later on. Accordingly candidate can print admit card using his/her application number & password.

7.	Question: Is there negative mark for wrong answer?

No, there is no negative marking for wrong answer.	

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8.	Question: How many marks & how long is the examination?
Answer	
i.	Total Marks : 100
ii.	Duration of Examination: 90 minutes

9.	Question: What is the standard of the questions?
Answer	
Based on the BSc in Nursing curriculum and English Language Knowledge.	

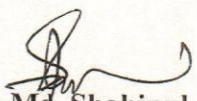
10.	Question: Can the information provided in the application form be modified?
Answer	
Candidate can modify their application as long as she/ he not pressed the 'Final Submit' button. Once the 'Final submit' button has been pressed, candidate is no longer allowed to modify.	

11.	Question: Can two courses be studied simultaneously?
Answer	
While studying MSN course, no other course can be studied.	

12.	Question: Can a candidate choose more than one discipline?
Answer:	
Yes, candidate can choose three disciplines (where options are available). After final submission, no change of discipline will be allowed.	

13.	Question: Can a candidate choose more than one institute?
Answer:	
Yes, candidate can choose either BMU or NIANER for the disciplines, (i) Women's Health and Midwifery Nursing, (ii) Nursing Management. Candidates who has already completed online form fill-up, can provide institute choice in the OMR Answer Script at the time of written Admission Test.	

14.	About any wrong/fake information :
If any candidate provide any wrong/fake information during online form fill-up or in any stage of admission process, his/her selection/admission will be cancelled and he/she will be subjected to legal proceedings as per procedures of Bangladesh Medical University.	


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
